Following PP/PT have been approved:

- PP CDIC
 Comparison of the dynamical cores of ICON and COSMO
 - leader: Michael Baldauf (DWD)
- PP T²(RC)² (9/15 9/17):
 Testing and Tuning of Revised Cloud Radiation Coupling
 - Leader: Harel Muskatel (IMS)
- PT TSA (9/15 9/16):
 Terra Stand Alone (Terra SAnta)
 - PT leader: Yiftach Ziv (IMS)







COSMO-LEPS:

the STC supports the extension of COSMO-LEPS to 20 members as proposed by ARPA-SIMC/WG7

GRIB2:

the STC approves the new GRIB2 policy proposed by the TAG/SMC (ensuring the sustainable use of GRIB2 by all COSMO Partners)

Rules for source code management:

the STC approves the new version of the document COSMO standards for with minor corrections (collaboration ICON / COSMO)



Other considerations



KENDA code:

the STC tasks the TAG together with WG1 and the ICON partners to define which quality assurance rules are feasible and useful for the software package CASDA, containing the modules developed LETKF and MEC, and how they can be implemented to ensure a good working collaboration COSMO / ICON.

Proposition to be submitted in 9/2016.



Strategy on verification tools (1)



- STC thanks the WG5 for the preparation of the document
- Decision on the CVS (common verification system):
 - Current CVS is VERSUS + VAST
 - 2. DWD tools to be evaluated by COSMO (starting 2016)
 - DWD tools possible CVS in ~2017, together with VERSUS + VAST for a transition period. (Maintenance of VERSUS + VAST ensured till 2017)
 - At the end of the transition period DWD tools could remain the only CVS
 - VERSUS becomes a AVT (additional verification tool) for the conditional verification



Strategy on verification tools (2)



- Decision on the AVTs (additional verification tools):
 - AVTs shall be provided to cover the additional common needs
 - New AVT shall be proposed by WG5 and approved by the STC after recommendation of the SMC
 - No development, but possible adaptation of tools might be necessary for new AVTs
 - Support should be available for the AVTs
 - Whenever possible the AVTs should use common formats (possibly using adaptors)



Elections
